To Apply

1. Complete & mail the attached vendor application by May 15, 2009. Cancellation deadline: June 1, 2009.
2. Enclose all checks and fees. Applications without fees will not be processed until fees arrive. Applications must be signed.
3. Food vendors are asked to provide proof of insurance.

** We ask that vendors limit their space requirements to a 20' x 20' space.

Vendor Guidelines

Food Vendors are asked to provide proof of insurance.

Food vendors must complete the **Temporary Restaurant Permit** required by the Virginia Department of Health.

The festival takes place **rain or shine**. Fees are non-refundable if not requested, in writing, by the cancellation date.

Alcohol is not permitted

Vendor Guidelines (cont.)

Set up time is Thursday morning, June 18, 2009 between 8 am and 3 pm. Early setup **WILL NOT** be possible due to the park having a function on Wednesday. Please contact the vendor coordinator to if you have any questions.

Electric (110) and water are included in the vendor fee. (220) Electric service which has been available in the past will not be provided this year because of problems experience last year. Generators are not permitted as they interfere with the performance atmosphere.

A limited number of vendors will be accepted because of space constraints. Preference will be given to local vendors and those who require the least amount of space and electric usage. **Sending in an application DOES NOT guarantee the vendor a space at the festival.**

Virginia State sales tax is the responsibility of the vendor.

Vendors must provide their own extension cords, trash receptacles, and water hoses.

All vendors must clean their area before leaving at the end of the festival.

No vehicles will be allowed in the vendor area during festival hours: Thursday and Friday, 5 pm to 11 pm, Saturday, 9 am to 11 pm.

Booth workers are admitted to the festival free of charge. A list of workers names should be submitted no later than June 10, 2008. The festival reserves the right to limit the number of workers on site at any given time.

Arrangements for camping should be made with Glen Maury Park. Vendors wishing to camp in the vendor area need to contact the vendor coordinator to make those arrangements. No camping in the vendor area will be allowed before the event begins on June 18th.
